Duke University Health System Seeks to Develop a New Diagnostic Center in Durham County

RALEIGH – Duke University Health System has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a diagnostic center in Morrisville – Duke Health Arringdon Radiology.

The project is expected to cost \$9.3 million and would be completed in July 2020.
