Applicant Seeks Approval for a 50-Bed Adult Care Home in Polk County

RALEIGH – Polk Opco Holdings LLC has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop The Gardens of Columbus, a 50-bed adult care home in Columbus.

The project is expected to cost \$5.9 million and would be completed in Sept. 2024.
