Approval Sought for Cost Overrun of Application to Relocate Hospital in Macon County

RALEIGH – MH Angel Medical Center, LLLP has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services for a cost overrun of a previously approved project to construct a replacement hospital in Franklin.

The capital cost of the original 2018 project was \$44.9 million. This cost overrun is expected to cost \$23.9 million, for a total capital cost of \$68.9 million. The project would be completed in Oct. 2022.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 18 at 10 a.m. in the Party Room of the Macon County Recreation Park Community Facilities Building, 1288 Georgia Road in Franklin.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Oct. 1.
