Applicants Compete for a Fixed MRI Scanner in Forsyth County

RALEIGH — Two competing certificate of need applications have been filed with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services for one fixed MRI scanner in Forsyth County.

The proposals are as follows:

Piedmont Imaging LLC and Novant Health Inc. propose to acquire one fixed MRI scanner to be located at Novant Health Imaging Piedmont in Winston-Salem. The project is expected to cost \$2 million and would be completed in July 2021.

Wake Forest Baptist Imaging LLC proposes to acquire one fixed MRI scanner to be located at Wake Forest Baptist Imaging – Kernersville. The project is expected to cost \$2.4 million and would be completed in January 2021.

A public hearing for these projects will be held Dec. 16 at 11 a.m. in the Municipal Courtroom, Kernersville Town Hall, 134 E. Mountain St., Kernersville.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Dec. 2.
