## **Two Applicants Seek Approval in Wake County**

RALEIGH – Raleigh Radiology, LLC and The Bone and Joint Surgery Clinic, LLP have filed certificate of need applications with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services.

Raleigh Radiology, LLC proposes to develop a new diagnostic center – Raleigh Radiology Cameron Village - in a medical office building in Raleigh. The project is expected to cost \$2.8 million and would be completed in January 2021.

The Bone and Joint Surgery Clinic, LLP proposes to expand the types of procedures performed on an existing MRI scanner acquired in 2006 at its facility as part of a demonstration project in Raleigh. The project is expected to cost \$90,000 and would be completed in April 2020.

Public hearings for these projects will be held consecutively on October 21 beginning at 10 a.m. in conference room 104, Brown Building, Dorothea Dix Campus, 809 Ruggles Drive, Raleigh.
