RALEIGH — Radiation Oncology Centers of the Carolinas LLC has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to replace its existing linear accelerator at Matthews Radiation Oncology Center in Matthews.

The project is expected to cost \$10.2 million and would be completed in January 2022.

A public hearing for this project will be held Jan. 16 at 1 p.m. in the Beatties Ford Road Regional Library, 2412 Beatties Ford Road, Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Dec. 31.
