# Written Comments Submitted on Behalf of Universal Properties/Brunswick, LLC and

### Universal Health Care/Brunswick Inc.

In accordance with N.C.G.S. Section 131E-185(a1)(1), Universal Properties/Brunswick, LLC and Universal Health Care/Brunswick (hereinafter collectively "Universal") submit the following comments regarding the February 15, 2012 Certificate of Need Application submitted by Dosher Memorial Hospital ("Dosher Memorial") for the March 1,2012 review cycle for Nursing Facility beds in Brunswick County.

The Dosher Memorial Application cannot be approved, because it is nonconforming with Criteria 3, 5, and 13. Universal has explained the reasons for the nonconformity below:

### **CRITERION 3**

Dosher Memorial does not adequately identify the proposed population to be served. The applicant stated that 7.7% of its proposed resident origin will be from outside Brunswick County without any documentation of the county from which these residents will originate. In addition, Dosher Memorial provided no documentation to substantiate why 7.7% of its residents would be from outside Brunswick County when the population in its existing beds is all from Brunswick County. (See Dosher Memorial's most recent license renewal application.)

### **CRITERION 5**

Dosher Memorial cannot establish the financial viability of the proposed project. Dosher Memorial submitted pro-forma financial statements which demonstrate a loss of \$1,959, 560 in the second year of operation. (See the enclosed attachment which compares the cost per patient to the competing applications.) Dosher Memorial is over \$48.00 per day more expensive than Universal Healthcare. Further, Dosher Memorial does not explain why the financial figures in the pro formas are based on 10 months instead of a full year.

**CRITERION 13** 

Dosher Memorial has not documented that the needs of the medically underserved groups such as

medically indigent or low income persons, Medicaid and Medicare recipients will be met.

Universal has calculated the percentage of each Brunswick County nursing facilities' populations

receiving Medicare and Medicaid assistance. The percentages are displayed below for Brunswick County

and explained further in the attached chart:

-Universal Healthcare: 86%

-Autumn Care: 91%

-Ocean Trail: 75%

-Brunswick Cove: 82%

-Dosher Memorial: 64%

Dosher Memorial projects that its percentage will increase to 67% with the proposed conversion.

In order to achieve 67% Dosher assumed that 85% of the 14 beds would be Medicaid, which is not a

reasonable assumption since there are currently 36% private pay in those beds.

ACCESSIBILITY

Dosher Memorial's location in Southport is less accessible to the entire population of Brunswick

County than Universal's location in Bolivia, which is centrally located in the County and located on the

major roads through Brunswick County.

**CONCLUSION** 

For the reasons noted above, Dosher Memorial's CON Application does not meet the criteria

necessary for approval. It does not properly identify the population to be served, is not financially

feasible, and does not demonstrate that it will meet the needs of the medically underserved. Universal is

the only approvable application since it meets all of the statutory criteria.
