I am writing to you in regarding the Certificate of Need application submitted by DaVita, Inc., operating as Total Renal Care of North Carolina, LLC, d/d/a Clayton Dialysis, for a ten-end station End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) outpatient hemodialysis facility in the city of Clayton, Johnston County, NC.

Previously, I had signed a letter of support for the aforementioned Certificate of Need submitted by Total Renal Care of North Carolina, LLC. However after further consideration, I am rescinding my support for the Clayton Dialysis project.

Based on the needs of the county, it would seem more reasonable to add an outpatient hemodialysis facility to the city that currently lacks ESRD care. Given that the city of Clayton already has an outpatient hemodialysis facility, the approval of Clayton Dialysis would not sufficiently meet the needs of the citizens of Johnston County.


