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Britthaven of Wrightsville to relocate

RALEIGH – Bowden Nursing Home, Inc, Wrightsville Health Investors, LLC and Wrightsville Health Holdings, Inc. have filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to relocate Britthaven of Wrightsville, an 80-bed nursing facility, to a new location in Wilmington.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on Aug. 20 in Room 338 in the McKeithan Center at Cape Fear Community College, 4900 Blue Clay Road, Castle Hayne.

The applicants propose to relocate the 80-bed nursing facility known as Britthaven of Wrightsville on Summer Rest Road in Wilmington to a new location on Carolina Beach Road in Wilmington, and will change the name of the facility to New Hanover Health and Rehabilitation Center. The project is expected to cost \$8.7 million.
