Total Renal Care of North Carolina to develop 10-station kidney disease treatment center in Youngsville

RALEIGH – Total Renal Care of North Carolina, LLC d/b/a Youngsville Dialysis has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a 10-station kidney disease treatment center in Youngsville by relocating eight stations from Dialysis Care of Franklin County and two stations from Wake Forest Dialysis Center.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 10:30 a.m. on June 13 in the Conference Room at Franklin County Public Library, Youngsville Branch, 218 U.S. 1-A South. Youngsville.

The project is expected to cost \$1.3 million and is expected to be complete by January 2015.
