#### Five in Chatham County compete for nursing facility beds

**RALEIGH** – Five competing applications have been filed with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to add nursing facility beds in Chatham County.

A public hearing for these projects will be held at 11 a.m. on Oct. 17 at the Chatham Community Library, Holmes Meeting Room, 197 N.C. Hwy 87 north, Pittsboro.

The 2013 State Medical Facilities Plan identifies a need for 90 additional nursing facility beds in Chatham County. A brief description of each proposed project follows:

- Kensington Rehab and Nursing Center proposes to develop a new 90-bed nursing facility on Lowes Drive in Pittsboro. The project is expected to cost \$9.2 million and be complete by January 2016.
- Chatham County Rehabilitation Center proposes to develop a new 90-bed nursing facility at U.S. 15-501 north and Sunny Acres Road in Pittsboro. The project is expected to cost \$15.7 million and be complete by October 2016.
- Chatham Health and Rehabilitation Center proposes to develop a new 90-bed nursing facility at 460 Henley Road in Chapel Hill. The project is expected to cost \$9.6 million and be complete by October 2016.
- UNC Hospitals Nursing Care and Rehabilitation Center proposes to develop a new 90-bed nursing facility at Chatham Park Complex in Pittsboro. The project is expected to cost \$10.9 million and be complete by November 2015.
- PruittHealth – Chatham proposes to develop a new 90-bed nursing facility at 1157 Hillsboro St., Pittsboro. The project is expected to cost \$11.8 million and be complete by October 2015.
