Strategic Behavioral Center-Garner proposes to add 12 psychiatric beds for children

RALEIGH – Strategic Behavioral Center-Garner has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to relocate 12 psychiatric beds from Broughton Hospital in Morganton to the existing facility in Garner.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 1 p.m. on Jan. 17 in Room 104 of the Brown Building on the Dorothea Dix Campus, 801 Biggs Drive, Raleigh.

The facility is currently licensed for 72 residential beds and 20 inpatient psychiatric beds. Twelve residential beds will be converted to inpatient psychiatric beds. The applicant does not anticipate any capital cost for the project which is expected to be complete in March 2014.
