Old Vineyard Behavioral Health Services seeks to add 50 beds in Forsyth County

RALEIGH – Old Vineyard Behavioral Health Services has filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to add 38 adult inpatient psychiatric beds and 22 child/adolescent psychiatric beds to its facility in Forsyth County.

A public hearing for this project will be held May 18 at 11 a.m. in Council Chambers of the Town of Kernersville Town Hall, 134 East Mountain St.

The project is expected to cost \$13.7 million and to be complete in January 2017.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 1.
