Novant Health proposes to replace and convert PET Scanner

RALEIGH – Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center has filed an application with the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to replace and convert an existing PET/CT scanner to a mobile PET/CT scanner.

A public hearing for this project will be held Aug. 18 at 1 p.m. in the Lower Level Conference Room, Room 7 of the Forsyth County Public Library, Kernersville Branch, 130 E. Mountain St., Kernersville.

The project is expected to cost \$2,548,643 and to be complete in October 2016.
