Two Applicants Compete for Operating Room in Union County

RALEIGH — Two applicants have filed competing certificate of need proposals with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services in response to a need determination in the 2017 State Medical Facilities Plan for one operating room in Union County.

A public hearing for these projects will be held July 17 at noon in Griffin Room, Union County Public Library, 316 E. Windsor St., Monroe. The proposals are as follows:

- Union West Surgery Center proposes to add a third operating room to its facility on Highway 74 in Indian Trail. The project is expected to cost \$4.1 million and be complete in March 2019.
- Presbyterian SameDay Surgery Center-Monroe proposes to add one operating room and one procedure room to its facility on Wellness Drive in Monroe. The project is expected to cost \$8,552,487 and be complete April 2019.

Anyone may file written comments concerning these proposals. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on July 3.
