Total Renal Care of North Carolina Asks to Develop Dialysis Facility in Lumberton

RALEIGH — Total Renal Care of North Carolina LLC has filed a certificate of need application with North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop Robeson County Dialysis, a 10-station end-stage renal disease facility, in Lumberton by relocating dialysis stations from Maxton Dialysis and Dialysis Care of Hoke County.

The project is expected to cost \$2.2 million and would be completed in January 2020.

A public hearing for this project will be held Nov. 16 at 10 a.m. in the Commissioners Conference Room of the Robeson County Administration Building, 701 North Elm St., Lumberton.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Oct. 31.
