Approval Sought for a Fixed MRI Scanner in Davie County

MOCKSVILLE, N.C. — Davie Medical Center and North Carolina Baptist Hospital have filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to acquire a fixed MRI scanner to be located at Davie Medical Center in Bermuda Run in response to the 2024 State Medical Facilities Plan need determination.

The project is expected to cost \$5.5 million and would be completed in January 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held June 19 at 10:30 a.m. in the conference room of the Davie County Public Library, 371 N. Main St. in Mocksville.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on May 31.
