Approval Sought to Relocate Two Operating Rooms in Forsyth County

WINSTON-SALEM, N.C. — North Carolina Baptist Hospital has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to relocate two operating rooms from the main campus of Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center to a new hospital outpatient department — Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist Outpatient Surgery – Innovation Quarter.

The project is expected to cost \$25 million and would be completed in May 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 14 at 11 a.m. at the Forsyth County Central Library, in the Dudley Room on the third floor, 660 W. 5th St. in Winston-Salem.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Oct. 1.
