Approval Sought for Change of Scope to Relocate Acute Care Beds in Mecklenburg County

CHARLOTTE — The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority LLC has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services for a change of scope to relocate no more than 23 acute care beds from Carolinas Medical Center to Atrium Health Lake Norman.

The project is expected to cost \$19 million and would be completed in April 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 11 at 11 a.m. in the Randolph Room of the Allegra Westbrooks Regional Branch of the Charlotte Mecklenburg Library, 2412 Beatties Ford Rd in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Oct. 1.
