PUBLIC NOTICE

Approval Sought for Acute Care Beds in Union County

MONROE, N.C. — The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop at Atrium Health Union West in Matthews, N.C., 46 additional acute care beds, pursuant to a need determination in the 2024 State Medical Facilities Plan; 11 additional emergency room bays; one additional gastrointestinal endoscopy room and one additional procedure room.

The project is expected to cost \$116.4 million and would be completed in October 2028.

A public hearing for this project will be held on Dec. 17 at 11 a.m. in the Hunley Room of the Union County Library, 316 E. Windsor St. in Monroe.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Dec. 2.
