## Approval Sought for Two Additional CT Scanners in Wake County

**RALEIGH** — Duke University Health System Inc. has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop two additional CT scanners at Duke Raleigh Hospital.

The project is expected to cost \$9.9 million and would be completed in July 2025.

A public hearing for this project will be held Aug. 20 at 11 a.m. at the Edgerton Building, conference room 26, on the Dorothea Dix Campus, 809 Ruggles Drive in Raleigh.
