Three Compete to Acquire a Fixed MRI Scanner in Wake County

RALEIGH — Three applicants have filed certificate of need applications with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to acquire a fixed MRI scanner in response to a need determination in the 2025 State Medical Facilities Plan for one fixed MRI scanner in Wake County.

Each applicant proposes one project.

RR WM Imaging Holly Springs LLC proposes to:

- Acquire one fixed MRI scanner at Raleigh Radiology Holly Springs. The project is expected to cost \$2.3 million and would be completed in February 2026.

Raleigh Radiology LLC proposes to:

- Acquire one fixed MRI scanner at Raleigh Radiology Blue Ridge in Raleigh. The project is expected to cost \$2.29 million and would be completed in February 2026.

Duke University Health System Inc. proposes to:

- Acquire one fixed MRI scanner at Duke Imaging Garner. The project is expected to cost \$5.7 million and would be completed in October 2026.

A public hearing for these projects will be held August 18 at 10:30 a.m. in conference room 26 in the Edgerton Building, 809 Ruggles Drive, Raleigh.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on July 31.
