Approval Sought for Additional Operating Rooms in Davidson County

LEXINGTON, N.C. — Lexington Medical Center has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop two additional operating rooms at Lexington Medical Center pursuant to the need determination in the 2025 State Medical Facilities Plan.

The project is expected to cost \$6.6 million and would be completed in June 2029.

A public hearing for this project will be held June 18 at 10 a.m. in the large meeting room of the Davidson County Library, 602 South Main Street in Lexington.

Anyone may file written comments concerning these proposals. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on June 2.
