

## RE: New Hanover Regional Medical Center's Exemption Request for a Medical Office Building

Dear Mr. Smith and Mr. Yakaboski:

New Hanover Regional Medical Center ("NHRMC"), intends to construct a Medical Office Building (MOB) to house physician offices at 1415 Physicians Drive, Wilmington, NC, 28401. Current plans for the MOB include space for physician offices, specifically Cape Fear Heart Associates, an employed physician group within the New Hanover Physician Group network. The services to be provided relative to these physician offices constitute components of a physician practice and not components of a licensed health service facility; therefore, they are exempt from review under N.C.G.S. § 131E-184(a)(9).

Please note that while the majority of the building will house physician offices, NHRMC currently plans to relocate one hospital-based service to the building. Therefore, a concurrent No Review Request accompanies this Exemption request for confirmation that this relocation of this service, specifically our outpatient cardiac testing, to a portion of this MOB is not subject to CON review.

Based upon the project as described above and pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 131E-184(a)(9), this letter serves as notification of our intent to proceed with this project. We would appreciate your written confirmation that the development of the MOB, other than the hospital-based service addressed in the concurrently filed No Review Request, is exempt from CON review.
