Dear Mr. Chinn

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that based on your letter of November 30, 2015, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, MSA Home Health and Hospice of NC, Inc. may proceed to acquire the above referenced health service facility without first obtaining a certificate of need. However, you need to contact the Agency's & (Section Name) Section to obtain instructions for changing ownership of the existing facility. Note that pursuant to G.S. 131E-181(b): "A recipient of a certificate of need, or any person who may subsequently acquire, in any manner whatsoever permitted by law, the service for which that certificate of need was issued, is required to materially comply with the representations made in its application for that certificate of need."

It should be noted that this Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this Agency and a separate determination. Dear Ms. Frisone:

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Service Regulation ("DHSR"), Certificate of Need Section (the "CON Section") that MSA Home Health and Hospice of NC, Inc., a North Carolina corporation ("MSA-NC") will be purchasing substantially all of the assets of Albemarle Regional Health Services, a North Carolina district public health department and public authority ("ARHS") owned and used in connection with the operation of Albemarle Hospice, a licensed and certified hospice agency (License No. HOS1677) ("Hospice Agency"), which this transaction is exempt from certificate of need ("CON") review under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(8).

I. THE PROPOSAL

Effective on or about December 1, 2015, MSA-NC will be acquiring substantially all of the Hospice Assets of ARHS with respect to the Hospice Agency. MSA-NC is a wholly owned subsidiary of Medical Services of America, Inc., a Virginia corporation ("MSA") based out of Lexington, South Carolina. The real property associated with the Hospice Agency is currently owned by ARHS and will be leased to MSA-NC effective as of the closing of the transaction pursuant to a separate lease agreement. MSA-NC also will be submitting a change of ownership application to DHSR to effectuate the transfer of the Hospice Agency license.

II. EXEMPTION NOTICE

Under North Carolina law, a CON is required prior to offering or developing a "new institutional health service." A "new institutional health service" includes a variety of equipment, services and activities, including the establishment of a hospital or a hospice agency office. However, the North Carolina General Assembly has exempted certain types of proposals from

CON review under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184, including the acquisition of an existing health service facility.¹

In this transaction, MSA-NC will be acquiring an existing "health service facility," and after the transaction, MSA-NC will continue to operate this health service facility as a hospice agency at its current location. Furthermore, the proposed transaction does not entail the acquisition of any major medical equipment or any per se reviewable equipment as defined in N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 131E-176(14)(o) and (16)(f1). Likewise, the transaction does not include the offering of any per se reviewable services except those already offered by the existing health service facility. Thus, given that the transaction involves only the sale of an existing health service facility, it is exempt from CON review.

III. CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing information, we hereby request the Agency's confirmation that the transaction described in Section II above is exempt from CON review, under N.C. Gen. Stat. §131E-184(a)(8).
