Dear Mr. Goins:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that based on your letter of July 6, 2015 and email dated July 17, 2015, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, Lutheran Home Forsyth County Property, Inc. may proceed to acquire the above referenced health service facility from Lutheran Home Winston-Salem Property, Inc. (Lessor) without first obtaining a certificate of need. However, you need to contact the Agency's Nursing Home Licensure and Certification Section to obtain instructions for changing ownership of the existing facility. Note that pursuant to G.S. 131E-181(b): "A recipient of a certificate of need, or any person who may subsequently acquire, in any manner whatsoever permitted by law, the service for which that certificate of need was issued, is required to materially comply with the representations made in its application for that certificate of need."

It should be noted that this Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this Agency and a

I appreciate your quick response to my attached letter requesting an "Exemption from Review". Unfortunately, I erroneously listed the wrong corporation. The letter should have read as follows:

In 2008, Lutheran Home-Forsyth County, Inc. (the licensed operator and lessee of the building) and Lutheran Home Winston-Salem Property, Inc. (the owner of the building and lessor) received a Certificate of Need to relocate beds and develop a 100-bed nursing facility in, Clemmons, Forsyth County. That project is open, licensed and serving residents. Its license number is NH0641.


