I am writing to inform you of the development of a physician office building in Oxford, North Carolina, to house a Duke Primary Care clinic. Duke University Health System will be leasing a building to be developed by TKC CCIII, LLC. The building will be located at the site identified on the enclosed map located at 1490 Williamsboro St/US 158, Oxford, NC. As the projected total capital cost for the upfit of the leased space, including both Duke's capital cost and the landlord's upfit allowance, exceeds \$2 million, we wanted to give notice of this project as required for an exempt development under N.C.G.S. 131E-184(a)(9).


Duke's leased space will not house any new institutional health services that would otherwise require certificate of need review. Please let me know if you have any questions. Thank you very much.
