The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that based on your letter of September 10, 2015, the above referenced proposals are exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, (1) 920 Junior High School Road, LLC may proceed to acquire Scotland Manor Health Care Center without first obtaining a certificate, of need, and (2) 604 West Stokes Street, LLC may proceed to acquire Creekside Care & Rehabilitation Center without first obtaining a certificate of need. However, you need to contact the Agency's Nursing Home Care Licensure and Certification Section to obtain instructions for changing ownership of the existing facilities. Note that pursuant to G.S. 131E-181(b): "A recipient of a certificate of need, or any person who may subsequently acquire, in any manner whatsoever
