Dear Ms. Kirkman:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of September 18, 2015, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(4). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Dear Ms. Frisone:

This letter serves as notification of The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Carolinas Medical Center's ("CMC") intent to replace mechanical equipment located in its H-wing. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 131E-184(a)(4), this project is exempt from certificate of need review. The H-wing, which was constructed in 1985, contains six operating rooms and their associated support spaces. Mechanical equipment for the H-wing is located on the eighth floor. All of the mechanical equipment located in the eighth floor mechanical room is nearing the end of its useful life and is in need of replacement. This equipment consists of the following:

- 1. Eleven air handling units,
- 2. Two chillers,
- 3. Two cooling towers,
- 4. Hydronic pumps,
- 5. One liquid desiccant unit, and
- 6. Steam and steam condensate systems.

The new mechanical equipment will be installed and operational prior to removing the existing units.

Additionally, CMC intends to replace two air handling units which are nearing the end of their useful lives and in need of replacement. Each of the air handling units currently serve eight operating rooms (sixteen in total). The replacement will include the use of temporary air handling units and a temporary electrical generator. The construction is planned to be completed in multiple phases in order to keep operating room downtime to a minimum. These air handling units are located in the basement of the main campus. The replacement equipment will be shipped to CMC in multiple pieces and then be constructed on-site in the mechanical room.

The estimated total capital cost for this project is approximately \$6,000,000.

Based upon the project as described above and pursuant to N.C.G.S 131E-184(a)(4), this letter serves as notification of our intent to proceed with this project. We would appreciate your written concurrence that this project is exempt from certificate of need review.
