The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of August 18, 2016, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(g). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Dear Ms. Frisone:

This letter outlines Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center's (NHPMC's) project to renovate and update its existing Behavioral Health Unit located on 7E in the main building on the Charlotte campus. The project cost is estimated to exceed \$2 million and is exempt from Certificate of Need (CON) review by the CON Section for the reasons set forth in this letter. The estimated total capital costs for this project are \$10,035,716 (See Attachment A). A Certified Architect's Letter regarding the construction costs of \$8,408,790 is included as Attachment B.

This project is exempt from CON review and meets the criteria set forth in NCGS § 131E-184(g) as follows:

1. The sole purpose of the capital expenditure is to renovate, replace on the same site, or expand the entirety or a portion of an existing health service facility that is located on the main campus;

This project is to renovate the existing 7E Behavioral Health Unit space located on the 7th floor of Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center, 200 Hawthorne Lane, Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina. The location on Hawthorne Lane is the "main campus" for NHPMC as it is the site from which NHPMC "provides clinical patient services and exercises financial and administrative control over the entire facility." NHPMC and its campus has been located at this address since 1918. Refer to Attachment C and D for location documentation.

2. The capital expenditure does not result in (i) a change in bed capacity as defined in GS 131E-176(5) or (ii) the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service facility or any other new institutional health service other than that allowed in GS 131E-176(16)b.;

The renovation of 7E will not result in a change in bed capacity or in the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service facility. The space for the existing licensed Psychiatric Beds on 7E is to be renovated and updated in its current location in the main hospital. See **Attachment E** documenting the existing, licensed psychiatric beds per Table 15A of the 2016 North Carolina State Medical Facilities Plan.

3. The licensed health service facility proposing to incur the capital expenditure shall provide prior written notice to the Department along with supporting documentation to demonstrate it meets the exemption criteria of this subsection.

This correspondence and supporting documentation serves as the required notice to the CON Section that the 7E renovation project meets the exemption criteria.

In conclusion, based on the information described above, please confirm that NHPMC's project to renovate and update the 7E Behavioral Health Unit fits within the exemption requirements at NCGS § 131E-184(g), therefore making it exempt from CON review.

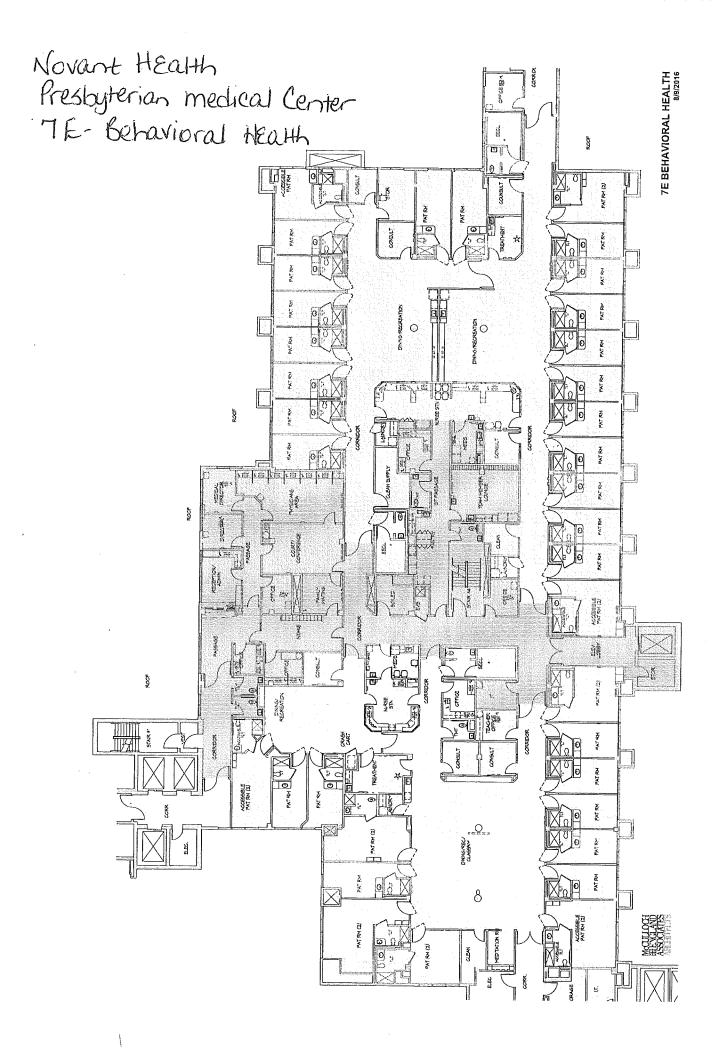
