Dear Mr. Puleo:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that based on your letter dated January 4, 2016 and received in our office on January 14, 2016, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, Omega HealthCare Investors, Inc. and SHG Autumn, LLC may proceed to acquire the health service facilities listed in the table in Attachment A without first obtaining a certificate of need. However, you need to contact the Agency's Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Section to obtain instructions for changing ownership of the existing facility. Note that pursuant to G.S. 131E-181(b): "A recipient of a certificate of need, or any person who may subsequently acquire, in any manner whatsoever permitted by law, the service for which that certificate of need was issued, is required to materially comply with the representations made in its application for that certificate of need."

It should be noted that this Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this Agency and a

Dear Ms. Frisone:

We are writing to provide the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section and your department with advance notice of Omega and SHG Autumn, LLC's planned acquisition via a joint stock-asset purchase of the North Carolina health service facilities (the "Facilities") listed on Exhibit A. We respectfully request that you provide confirmation that the proposed acquisitions are exempt from Certificate of Need ("CON") review.

Omega intends to purchase from the current owner 100% of the assets of sixteen (16) Facilities, and SHG Autumn, LLC intends to purchase 100% of the operations of the same Facilities via a stock sale. The acquisition of 100% interest of the current licensees will involve the purchase of the real property by Omega and operations by SHG Autumn, LLC for thirteen (13) of the Facilities. SHG Autumn, LLC will be purchasing the operations and assuming the existing leases for the remaining three (3) Facilities. Exhibit A shows the Facilities for which the real property will be purchased, as well as the Facilities which will continue to be leased.

As you know, North Carolina CON law provides that, upon receiving prior written notice, the Department of Health and Human Services shall exempt from CON review the acquisition of "an existing health service facility, including equipment owned by the health service facility at the time of the acquisition." N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(8). The CON law further provides that a nursing home facility is a health service facility. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(9b).

The parties currently plan to close this transaction on or about January 29, 2016. It would be very helpful if you could provide a written confirmation that the acquisition of these existing health service facilities as set forth in detail in <u>Exhibit A</u> are exempt from CON review by January 15, 2016.
