The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that based on your letter of March 7, 2016, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, HP6 Clayton Health Investors, LLC may proceed to acquire the above referenced health service facility without first obtaining a certificate of need. 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

I am writing on behalf of HP6 Clayton Health Investors, LLC (the "Buyer"), to provide notice to the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Service Regulation, Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section (the "Agency") of a transaction involving Clayton House (License Number HAL-051-041), a licensed adult care home located at 145 Dairy Road, Clayton, Johnston County), North Carolina (the "Facility").

The Facility is currently owned by IP Clayton Properties, LLC. The Facility is leased to and operated by Clayton Health Holdings, LLC (the "Current Licensee"). Pursuant to the transaction, the Facility will be acquired by Buyer. Following the conclusion of the transaction, the Facility will continue to be operated as an adult care home, and the Facility will continue to be operated by the Current Licensee pursuant to its lease agreement with the Buyer.

The acquisition of the Facility will not involve the development of any new health service facility or otherwise qualify as a "new institutional health service" which would be subject to review under applicable Certificate of Need statutes or regulations. Pursuant to this letter, the Buyer hereby requests that the Agency confirm that the acquisition of the Facility is exempt from Certificate of Need review and approval pursuant to Section 131E-184(a)(8) of the North Carolina General Statutes.
