The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of April 26, 2016, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(9). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in

The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Carolinas Medical Center is planning to construct and operate a 260,000 square foot physician office building on the campus of Carolinas Medical Center in Charlotte. The project includes the construction of seven floors as an expansion of and adjacent to the existing Levine Cancer Institute building located at 1021 Morehead Medical Drive that was constructed in 2011.
