

This letter is to provide the Certificate of Need Section with prior written notice of the development of a physician office building in Raleigh, North Carolina. The Duke University Health System will upfit space leased from Byrd Falls Medical, LLC, at 7021 Harps Mill Road in the Wakefield region of Wake County, to house an urgent care practice. This practice will not be operated as part of any licensed health service facility and no other new institutional health services will be developed at this location without first seeking any appropriate Certificate of Need approvals. This project will enable Duke to address the primary care and other medical needs of the population in this area.
