The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of December 13, 2017, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with N.C. I am writing to inform you of the proposed upfit of leased space by the Duke University Health System in a physician office building located at 10208 Cerny Street in Brier Creek in Wake County at a cost that is projected to exceed \$2 million.
