Dear Ms. Kirkman:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of February 20, 2017, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §131E-184(g). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure & Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

RE: Request for Exemption from Review to Renovate the Hemotological Oncology Unit and Related Space on 4 Tower at The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Carolinas Medical Center (CMC)

Dear Ms. Frisone:

I am writing to inform you of The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Carolinas Medical Center's plan to renovate its Hemotological Oncology Unit ("HemOnc Unit") and related space located in 4 Tower on CMC's main campus.

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 131E-184(g), "[t]he Department shall exempt from certificate of need review any capital expenditure that exceeds the two million dollar (\$2,000,000) threshold set forth in G.S. 131E-176(16)b. if any of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The sole purpose of the capital expenditure is to renovate, replace on the same site, or expand the entirety or a portion of an existing health service facility that is located on the main campus.
- (2) The capital expenditure does not result in (i) a change in bed capacity as defined in G.S. 131E-176(5) or (ii) the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service facility or any other new institutional health service other than that allowed in G.S. 131E-176(16)b.
- (3) The licensed health service facility proposing to incur the capital expenditure shall provide written notice to the Department along with support documentation to demonstrate that it meets the exemption criteria of this subsection."

N.C.G.S. 131E-176(14n) states "'Main campus' means all of the following for the purposes of G.S. 131E-184(f) and (g) only:

- a. The site of the main building from which a licensed health service facility provides clinical patient services and exercises financial and administrative control over the entire facility, including the buildings and grounds adjacent to that main building.
- b. Other areas and structures that are not strictly contiguous to the main building but are located within 250 yards of the main building."

The Carolinas Medical Center HemOnc Unit renovation project meets each of the applicable conditions set forth above. The estimated total capital cost of the project exceeds \$2,000,000 (see Attachment A for a capital cost worksheet and a certified construction cost estimate). The proposed project involves the renovation of an existing health service facility located at 1000 Blythe Boulevard, Charlotte, NC 28203, which is the site from which Carolinas Medical Center provides clinical patient services and exercises financial and administrative control over the entire facility (see Attachment B). Carolinas Medical Center's President's office is located on the second floor of the main hospital building. Please see a copy of Carolinas Medical Center's license in Attachment C.

The project consists of renovation only and does not involve a change in bed capacity as defined in G.S. 131E-176(5) or the addition of a health service facility or a new institutional health service. The project will not increase the number of operating rooms or gastrointestinal rooms. The project will not result in the acquisition of major medical equipment or the offering of health services not currently provided.

The project involves the renovation of space on the fourth, ninth, tenth and eleventh floors as well as the first level of the Annex of Carolinas Medical Center (see Attachment D for floor plans).

HemOnc Unit Renovations

In 2012, CMC renovated existing space on the fourth floor (4B) for a 16-bed medical/surgical unit (#F-8827-12) to house existing adult hematologic oncology services. CMC is now proposing to renovate existing medical/surgical space (4T) in order to accommodate additional adult hematologic oncology patients. Hematologic oncology patients are immunocompromised and highly susceptible to infections. The proposed project will enable CMC to provide a controlled environment for additional hematologic oncology patients.

The project involves renovation of space primarily on the fourth floor but also includes minor renovations on the ninth, tenth and eleventh floors in addition to the first level of the Annex on CMC's main campus. There are currently 35 licensed medical/surgical beds on the fourth floor tower ("4T"). Following completion of construction, there will be 30 licensed beds on 4T. The five remaining licensed medical/surgical beds will be relocated within CMC as follows:

- One licensed medical/surgical bed to 9T room 9930
- Two licensed medical/surgical beds to 8L rooms 8621 and 8622
- Two licensed medical surgical beds to 10A rooms 10125 and 10127

This project also includes renovations to the stem cell lab and the oncology pharmacy. The pharmacy is currently located on 2L. Following completion of the proposed project, the oncology portion of the pharmacy will be relocated to the fourth floor in what is currently PT/OT office and storage space. PT/OT office and storage space will be relocated to the fourth floor, the ninth floor, the tenth floor, and the eleventh floor. In addition, PT/OT will relocate offices to the first floor of the Annex building.

Summary

Based on the above facts, the project is exempt from certificate of need review. We are requesting that you confirm in writing that Carolinas Medical Center's HemOnc Unit renovation is exempt from certificate of need review and that we may proceed as planned with this project.






Level 02 Enlarged Existing Plan

Level 04 Enlarged Proposed Pharmacy/Stem Cell/PT-OT













Hemotological Oncology Renovations

Level 10 Enlarged Proposed Plan




EXISTING BUILDING




