Dear Ms. Kirkman:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) received your letter of March 22, 2017 regarding the above referenced proposal. Based on the CON law in effect on the date of this response to your request, the proposal described in your correspondence is not governed by, and therefore, does not currently require a certificate of need. However, please note that if the CON law is subsequently amended such that the above referenced proposal would require a certificate of need, this determination does not authorize you to proceed to develop the above referenced proposal when the new law becomes effective.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Certification and Licensure Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented in your correspondence. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by this office. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the

RE: No Review Request to Verify Non-Reviewability of Project to Renovate Carolinas HealthCare System Steele Creek Emergency Department, a hospital department of Mercy Hospital, Inc. d/b/a Carolinas HealthCare System Pineville

Dear Ms. Frisone:

Mercy Hospital, Inc. d/b/a Carolinas HealthCare System Pineville (CHS Pineville) owns and operates a freestanding Emergency Department, Carolinas HealthCare System Steele Creek (CHS Steele Creek) in Charlotte, Mecklenburg County.

The CHS Steele Creek Emergency Department plans to renovate and expand the number of emergency room bays by adding eight vertical care bays to accommodate low acuity patients. The proposed capital cost is under \$2,000,000. Through this letter, CHS Pineville requests confirmation from the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Service Regulation, Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section (the "Agency") that the renovation project described herein is not subject to certificate of need review.

Because the renovation and addition of emergency room vertical care bays does not trigger any of the Certificate of Need ("CON") Law's new institutional health service definitions in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(16), CHS Pineville asks to do this without undergoing CON review.

This proposed project does not trigger any of the new institutional health service definitions in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(16). The construction costs associated with renovating and expanding the CHS Steele Creek emergency department will not exceed \$2,000,000, and thus will not trigger the capital cost threshold in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(16)(b). See Attachment A (certified cost estimate) and Attachment B (line drawing showing the proposed renovations).

Based on the above facts, CHS Pineville requests you confirm in writing that CHS Pineville's renovation is exempt from certificate of need review and that we may proceed as planned with this project.
