Dear Ms. Zerman:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of March 10, 2017, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(4). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Dear Ms. Thorne-Williams:

UNC Hospitals is providing notice of a project exempt from review regarding upgrades to the existing Hillsborough campus chiller plant pursuant to §NCGS 131E-184(a)(4) Exemptions from Review. §NCGS 131E-184(a)(4) Exemptions from Review requires that "...the Department shall exempt from certificate of need review a new institutional health service if it receives prior written notice from the entity proposing the new institutional health service, which notice includes an explanation of why the new institutional health service is required, for any of the following:

(4) To provide parking, heating or cooling systems, elevators, or other basic plant or mechanical improsements, unless these activities are integral portions of a project that involves the construction of a new health service facility or portion thereof and that is subject to certificate of need review."

UNC Hospitals at Hillsbough was licensed June 23, 2015 and operational beginning July 6, 2015. During the heat of last summer, it became apparent that the an upgrade of the existing cooling system was required to ensure adequate cooling for the upcoming summer. The upgrade is projected to cost \$3M. The project involves the addition of a third chiller and fourth cooling tower in the central utility plant. To accomplish this, the mechanical contractor will rework the existing chilled water piping and valves. Also, the electrical contractor will coordinate with Duke Energy to provide a new transformer because of the increased power load caused by the third chiller. Additional electrical feeders will also be installed. This project does not involve the addition of any licensed beds, major medical equipment, licensed programs, health services, or any health care service renovations.

Therefore, in consideration of the above, we understand that this project is exempt from CON review. UNC Hospitals is requesting confirmation that the proposed chiller upgrades are exempt from review pursuant to §NCGS. 131E-184(a)(4).
