RE: Exemption Notification for Physician Office Building

Dear Ms. Frisone:

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §131E-184(a)(9), I am writing you to provide prior notice of Granville Health System's intent to develop a physician office building on the campus of Granville Medical Center in Oxford. The cost of the project has not yet been finalized but is expected to exceed \$2 million.

At present, the first floor of the building is expected to house primary care physician offices. The second floor will also be available to house physician offices, but no specific practices have been identified to date. No new institutional health services are expected to be offered or developed in the building. Specifically, the building will not house a health service facility as defined in N.C.G.S. §131E-176(9)(b), nor does Granville Health System propose to acquire any major medical equipment or any equipment listed in N.C.G.S. §131E-176(16)(f1).

Based on these facts and the prior notice given with this letter, Granville Health System believes that the construction of the physician office building is exempt from review. I would appreciate a written response to confirm that you agree with this understanding.
