Notice of Exemption for Medical Office Building in Mecklenburg County,

North Carolina (HSA III)

Dear Ms. Frisone:

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9), this letter serves as prior written notice of Novant Health, Inc.'s ("Novant") intention to build a 7,400 square foot medical office building ("MOB") located at 3149 Freedom Drive, Charlotte, North Carolina 28208. The MOB will house Novant Health Medical Group physician offices. No new institutional health services as defined in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(16)a.-v. will be constructed, developed, established or offered in the MOB. Novant plans to acquire one x-ray machine at a cost of \$104,950, which is well below the \$500,000 threshold for a diagnostic center pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(7a). See equipment quote attached as **Exhibit A**. Novant plans to begin construction on the MOB later this year and expects to open the MOB in 2019.

We would appreciate the CON Section's written confirmation that the MOB is exempt from CON review pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9). If you should need any additional information, please let me know.


