The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that based on your letter of February 12, 2018, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, Ridgewood Propco may proceed to acquire the above referenced health service facility without first obtaining a certificate of need. However, you need to contact the Agency's Nursing Home Licensure and Certification Section to obtain instructions for changing ownership of the existing facility. Note that pursuant to G.S. 131E-181(b): "A recipient of a certificate of need, or any person who may subsequently acquire, in any manner whatsoever permitted by law, the service for which that certificate of need was issued, is required to materially comply with the representations made in its application for that certificate of need."

It should be noted that this Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this Agency and a separate determination. Dear Ms. Frisone:

We represent Ridgewood Healthcare, LLC ("Ridgewood") and Ridgewood Propco, LLC, which are related entities. In 2016, Ridgewood acquired certain assets and operational rights of a skilled nursing facility known as Ridgewood Living & Rehabilitation Center ("Ridgewood Living"). Ridgewood Living is a 150 bed facility located in Washington, Beaufort County, North Carolina.

In May of 2016, Ridgewood sought and received a No Review Determination from your Agency. *See* Attachment A. As stated in our May 12, 2016 letter, the bricks and mortar of Ridgewood Living are owned by RNH Health, LLC. Ridgewood is currently the licensee and leasee of the facility.

On February 5, 2018, Ridgewood provided notice to the Agency that it would be acquiring the bricks and mortar of Ridgewood Living and requested that the Agency confirm that the proposed transaction is exempt from CON review. See Attachment B. Ridgewood would like to amend its request to reflect that the bricks and mortar of Ridgewood Living will be acquired by Ridgewood Propco. Upon closing of the transaction, which is expected to take place in the coming months, Ridgewood will continue to be the licensee and Ridgewood Propco will become the owner of the bricks and mortar of the facility. Please confirm that the acquisition described above is exempt from Certificate of Need review under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(8).
