Bio-Medical Applications of North Carolina, Inc., d/b/a FMC Brunswick County seeks a Determination of Material Compliance, allowing BMA to add home hemodialysis training and support at the facility.

The facility was developed by way of CON Project ID # O-6892-11. The CON was issued October 14, 2011. The facility was certified effective August 29, 2012. There have been no changes to the facility since its original certification.

At this time, the facility has an in-center hemodialysis patient requesting to transition to home hemodialysis. BMA is not certified to provide home hemodialysis training and support, and therefore seeks to a Determination of Material Compliance allowing the facility to add this service.

The facility is already certified to provide home peritoneal dialysis training and support. BMA will utilize the same home training area for the home hemodialysis training and support services. Therefore no capital expenses will be related to this additional service.
