# Dear Ms. Runyon:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of August 14, 2019, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §131E-184(a)(4). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.



Dear Ms. Frisone:

UNC Hospitals is providing this prior written notice of a project exempt from Certificate of Need ("CON") review. UNC Hospitals in Chapel Hill plans to provide a new facility to house the electrical generators required to provide emergency power for the UNC Medical Center, and to improve and upgrade its current normal and emergency power equipment. This exemption is pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(4), which provides that:

- (a) [T]he Department shall exempt from certificate of need review a new institutional health service if it receives prior written notice from the entity proposing the new institutional health service, which notice includes an explanation of why the new institutional health service is required, for any of the following:
  - (4) To provide parking, heating or cooling systems, elevators, or other basic plant or mechanical improvements, unless these activities are integral portions of a project that involves the construction of a new health service facility or portion thereof and that is subject to certificate of need review.

This project meets all criteria outlined above for the exemption to CON Law. Specifically, the sole purpose of the capital expenditure is to provide basic plant or mechanical improvements by providing a facility to house the generators required to provide emergency power for the UNC Medical Center. Normal and emergency power equipment will also be modernized as part of this project. These activities are not an integral portion of any project that involves the construction of a new health service facility or portion thereof or that is subject to CON review. Instead, this project relates to plant maintenance and necessary mechanical upgrades to UNC Hospitals, an existing health service facility. Attached as Exhibit 1 is a more detailed description of the scope of the project.

This correspondence and the supporting exhibits serve as the explanation of why this project is required, and provide prior written notice of UNC Hospitals' intention to incur the capital expenditure for this project. UNC Hospitals anticipates that it will spend approximately \$78,736,286.22 to complete this project. A certified cost estimate is attached as Exhibit 2.

In consideration of the above, we request written confirmation that this project is exempt from CON review pursuant to §NCGS. 131E-184(a)(4). Please do not hesitate to contact me at 984-215-3622 if you need any additional information. Thank you for your prompt consideration of this matter.

This is to certify that the project noted above complies with the North Carolina State Building Code and as reasonable and within budget includes sustainable initiatives such as high efficiency LED lighting and plumbing fixtures.

The scope of this project is as follows:

- Installation of a new ~12,000 square foot Central Generator Plant adjacent to and in dedicated service of the existing UNC Medical Center campus and its new Surgical Tower addition under construction (by others). The new central plant will house 12,000 kilowatts of emergency standby power diesel-engine-driven electric generators, in compliance with UNCH's Emergency Operations Plan.
- Electrical equipment modernization of several existing UNC Medical Center main electrical rooms serving the existing Old Hospital/APCF Building, NC Women's and Children's Hospital, NC Neuroscience Hospital, Anderson Pavilion, and the Patient Services Tower.
- Installation of new underground electrical wiring interconnecting the new central plant to the
  existing UNC Medical Center renovated electrical rooms and the proposed Surgical Tower
  addition (by others).

The electrical rooms modernization and new underground wiring installations do not increase energy or water consumption. The new central plant is a stand-alone building that will increase the UNC Hospitals overall energy and water consumption.
