The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of February 1, 2019, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §131E-184(a)(9). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and the Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed physician office.

RE: Exemption Notice filed by the University of North Carolina Health Care System for Physician Office Building in Cary, Wake County

Dear Ms. Frisone:

On behalf of our client the University of North Carolina Health Care System ("UNCHCS") we are notifying you of a change regarding the development of a physician office building (the "Exempt Office Building") in Cary, North Carolina, at the corner of McCrimmon Parkway and N.C. Highway 55.

This Exemption Notice is for the Exempt Office Building, which was originally approved by the Agency for development by Craig Davis Properties.

UNCHCS will not develop any CON reviewable projects in the Exempt Office Building. Rather, UNCHCS will lease space to entities which may, in turn, develop projects which are either CON approved or non-reviewable. For example, the following projects are being developed in the Exempt Office Building by other entities, who will be leasing space in the Exempt Office Building:

1. The Exempt Office Building will contain the previously approved Certificate of Need ("CON") Rex Hospital, Inc. ("Rex") project filed November 17, 2008 as Panther Creek Urgent Care and Diagnostics, Project ID #J-8263-08 (the "Panther Creek CON Project"), the CON for which was originally issued on July 27, 2010 to Rex Hospital, Inc. ("Rex"). Today, Rex, Wake Radiology Services, LLC ("WRS"), and their Joint Venture entity WR Imaging, LLC ("WR Imaging") filed a Good Cause Transfer and Material Compliance Request in order to obtain approval of Rex's plans with respect to the Joint Venture as they relate to the Panther Creek CON Project.

- 2. The Exempt Office Building will also contain the proposed Urgent Care Project, which was originally part of the Panther Creek CON Project described in Point #1 above, and for which Rex today filed a No Review Request to develop that Urgent Care Project separately from the Panther Creek CON Project.
- 3. The Exempt Office Building will also contain the proposed Lab Project, which was originally part of the Panther Creek CON Project described in Point #1 above, and for which Rex today filed a No Review Request to also develop that Lab Project separately from the Panther Creek CON Project.

UNCHCS is providing you notice that the developer of the MOB will now be UNCHCS. The Exempt Office Building will continue to be developed at the same location. Construction of the Exempt Office Building is expected to be completed by October 2019.

UNCHCS believes that the development of this Exempt Office Building by UNCHCS is exempt from CON review under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9). Exempt projects include projects "to develop or acquire a physician office building, regardless of cost, unless a new institutional health service other than defined in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(16)b. is offered or developed in the building." See N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9).

UNCHCS does not intend to develop any new institutional health services in this Exempt Office Building. As discussed above and elsewhere, the projects that will be contained in the Exempt Office Building are either CON approved or are non-reviewable.

Based on the foregoing information, UNCHCS hereby requests that the Agency provide a written response confirming that UNCHCS's development of the Exempt Office Building is exempt from CON review. If the Agency needs additional information to assist in its consideration of this request, please apprise us as soon as possible. We thank you for your consideration of this request.
