Dear Mr. Bashore:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that based on your letter of **April 14, 2020**, the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §131E-184(a)(4). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop, or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

However, you need to contact the Agency's Construction and Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Sections to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Dear Ms. Frisone

Gateway Ambulatory Surgery Center, LLC plans to update the steam system at Gateway Surgery Center, an ambulatory surgery center License No. AS0070. On behalf of Gateway Ambulatory Surgery Center, LLC, I am requesting that the Agency confirm that this planned investment is exempt from review under the statutory exemption provisions in N.C. Gen. Stat.§ 131E-184(a)(4).

The planned investment will replace the boiler and humidifier lines, maintaining a parallel system while the surgery center continues operations. This investment is necessary for continued operations and conformity with construction codes and is not integral to construction of a new institutional health service.

Exempt from Review

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 131 E-1 84(a) (4), "the Department shall exempt from certificate of need review a new institutional health service if it receives prior written notice from the entity proposing the new institutional health service if it receives prior written notice from the entity proposing the new institutional health service, which notice includes an explanation of why the new institutional health service is required for any of the following:

(4) To provide parking, heating or cooling systems, elevators, or any other basic plant or mechanical elements, unless these activities are integral portions of a project that involves the construction of a new health service facility or portions thereof and that is subject to certificate of need review.

The planned improvement project meets the applicable conditions set forth above:

- The project involves replacement of a boiler and steam lines that are inefficient for current operations. The original designs did not anticipate current demands for steam sterilization and the humidity lines are related.
- The capital expenditure will not result in a change in bed capacity or the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service other than that allowed by G.S 131E-l76(16)(b).
- This letter constitutes the required prior written notice.

Based on the foregoing, we respectfully request that the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section issue written confirmation that this project is exempt from Certificate of Need review under N.C.G.S § 131 E-184(a)4.
