# **Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI)**

The principles of diversity, equity and inclusion can and should:

- Be incorporated in the health care setting to create an environment that is person-centered
- Provide an equal opportunity for residents to achieve their best outcome
- Advance health care organizations to improve their performance

#### **Person-Centered Care**

Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) defines Person-centered care as medical treatment:

- Directed and informed by resident's wishes, choices and personal values
- Delivering measurable outcomes based on resident feedback
- Involving interdisciplinary care
- Managing multiple medical conditions
- Developing trusting relationships between resident and care providers

**Person-Centered Care Goals** 

- To help the resident meet needs for attachment, inclusion, sense of well-being, and comfort
- To support an individual as a member of a community
- To honor the importance of keeping the resident at the center of the care planning and decisionmaking process

# **Person-Centered Care Goals**

- To respect skills and abilities
- To support the resident to be successful and maintain independence
