Payor Sources for Home Care

- Medicare continues to be the largest payer of home health care services.
- Medicaid covers a great deal as well, as it includes in-home services that Medicare does not cover (e.g., personal care services).
- The remaining payor sources include state/local governments, private insurance, and out-of-pocket.






