## REQUEST

Petition Inpatient Hospice-1: Hospice and Palliative Care Center of Alamance-Caswell submitted a petition for five additional hospice inpatient beds in Alamance County.

Petition Inpatient Hospice-2: Home Care Services of Haywood Regional Medical Center submitted a petition for six hospice inpatient beds in Haywood County.

Petition Inpatient Hospice-3: Hospice of the Carolina Foothills submitted a petition to eliminate the need determination for six inpatient hospice in Polk County.

**Petition Inpatient Hospice-4**: Hospice of Scotland County submitted a petition for two hospice inpatient beds in Scotland County.

**Petition Inpatient Hospice-5**: Hospice of Wake County submitted a petition for ten additional hospice inpatient beds in Wake County.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Proposed 2009 Plan makes single county determinations when the County deficit is 6 or more beds based on the Standard Methodology except for counties that have 300 percent or greater days of care per 1000 population than the State average and also have an inpatient facility that has been licensed since January 1, 2006, or Certificate of Need approved beds, or need determinations in prior Plans. The hospice inpatient methodology bases total estimated inpatient days of care on 8% of total estimated days of care; projects inpatient beds based on 85% occupancy; and, adjusts projected beds for occupancy rates of existing facilities that are not at 85% occupancy.

Application of the methodology resulted in need determinations in eight counties for a total of 55 beds. The counties were Cabarrus, Catawba, Craven, Lincoln, Polk, Randolph, Sampson and Stokes. However, data revisions submitted for several hospice agencies results in changes to need determinations as published in the Proposed 2009 Plan. The data changes result in a six bed need determination for Alamance County, elimination of the six bed need determination for Randolph County, an increase in the need determination for Craven County from six to seven beds, and an increase in the need determination for Sampson County from ten to 11 beds. Attached to this report are revised Hospice Tables 13A, B and C incorporating

the data changes. It is noted that additional changes may be made to the data. Also, a need determination would be added for eight beds in Bladen County based on dismissal of a Certificate of Need (CON) appeal. In addition, due to no CON applications being filed for need determinations in Lee and Wilson Counties, there would be eight bed need determinations for Lee and Wilson counties.

# **Inventory Overview**

There are 23 hospice inpatient facilities (187 beds) in 21 of the state's 100 counties.

The following table lists, based on the Proposed 2009 Plan, counties with inpatient and residential beds, number of beds, % of county and statewide median percent of deaths served by hospice, and hospice days of care per 1000 population for the county and state.

The table indicates that except for four counties, counties with inpatient and/or residential beds have higher % of deaths served by Hospice than the state median. The table also indicates 14 of 25 counties have higher hospice days of care compared to the state average.

Further, as indicated in the following discussion regarding need determinations in plans prior to the Proposed 2009 Plan, several counties may be issued Certificates of Need to develop hospice inpatient beds in the future. They are: Brunswick (7), Cleveland (4), Cumberland (24), Forsyth (10), Gaston (7), Harnett (8), Henderson (7), and Johnston (4).

#### 2002 Plan.

The 2002 Plan was the first Plan since 1995 to contain a need determination for inpatient hospice beds. The 1995 Plan identified a need for 14 inpatient beds in Forsyth County based on the standard methodology in effect at that time.

The 2002 Plan contained single county need determinations for five counties; Cleveland, Cumberland, Gaston, Richmond and Rutherford. The need determinations for Cleveland (two beds) and Rutherford (four beds) were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Long-Term Care Committee in response to petitions filed by hospice agencies in these counties. Both Cleveland and Rutherford counties exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice and Hospice days of care per 1000 population. Also, the number of beds requested by the petitioners agreed with the deficits identified in the 2002 Plan. The need determinations for Cumberland, Gaston and Richmond counties were based on the Standard Methodology. No CON applications were filed for the Gaston or Richmond need determinations identified in the 2002 Plan.

## 2003 Plan

The 2003 Plan contained single county need determinations for seven counties. The need determinations for Catawba, Forsyth, Iredell, Mecklenburg and Union counties were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Long-Term Care Committee in response to petitions filed by Hospices in these counties. The need determinations for Gaston (6 beds) and Richmond counties (9 beds) were based on the Standard Methodology. No CON applications were filed for the Richmond and Union County need determinations.

All counties (except Iredell) that received adjusted need determinations, exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice and two of the five counties exceeded the state average Hospice days of care per 1000 population. Also, with regard to Catawba and Iredell counties, the number of beds requested by the petitioners agreed with the deficits identified in the 2003 Plan. Union County requested four beds, but the adjustment was for 3 beds which was consistent with the deficit identified in the Plan.

With regard to Forsyth County, the committee recommended that the petition for 6 additional beds be approved even though there was a surplus of 2 beds based on the standard methodology. As noted in the Agency Report, the Forsyth County facility had a high utilization rate (approximately 97% occupancy). Also, the facility indicated a daily waiting list of 5-6 patients and that 3,312 inpatient days were denied due to lack of availability to inpatient beds in Forsyth County which would equate to 11.3 additional beds at 80% occupancy. It was also noted that the Forsyth facility served a larger area than just Forsyth County and there was support from the community, hospitals and physicians.

With regard to Mecklenburg County, the petition requested 21 inpatient beds. The eleven beds allocated by the committee were consistent with the standard methodology if the existing unit at Presbyterian Hospital had been at 80% occupancy.

## 2004 Plan

The 2004 Plan contained single county need determinations for seven counties. The need determinations for Duplin, Henderson and Surry counties were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Committee in response to petitions filed by Hospices in these counties. The need determinations for Guilford, Durham, Richmond, and Robeson counties were based on the Standard Methodology. No CON applications were filed for the Durham, Richmond, or Robeson county need determinations.

Two of the three counties that received adjusted need determinations, exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice and the state average Hospice days of care per 1000 population. Also, with regard to Surry/Yadkin counties, the number of beds requested by the petitioner agreed with the deficits identified in the 2004 Plan.

With regard to Henderson County, the committee recommended that the petition for 6 additional beds be approved even though there was a <u>surplus</u> of 3 beds based on the standard methodology. The petitioner noted inpatient days had been constrained by the limitation on the number of beds (inpatient days decreased from 14.1% in 2000 to 11.8% in 2003). As noted in the Agency Report, the Henderson County facility had a high utilization rate

(approximately 91.5% occupancy). It was also noted that there was support from the hospital, physicians and other hospices.

With regard to Duplin County, the petitioner requested 3 inpatient beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for 3 beds even though the projected deficit was only one bed based on the standard methodology. The petitioner indicated issues related to distance from other inpatient hospice facilities, occasions when beds were not available, broad community support, and availability of funds for the project.

# 2005 Plan

The 2005 Plan contained single county need determinations for seven counties. The need determinations for Davidson, Pitt, Rockingham, and Wake counties were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Committee in response to petitions. The need determinations for Cumberland, Harnett and Robeson counties were based on the Standard Methodology. No CON applications were filed for the Cumberland County need determination.

One of the four counties that received adjusted need determinations exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice.

With regard to Pitt County, the committee recommended that the petition for 8 additional beds be approved even though there was a deficit of only 2 beds based on the standard methodology. The petitioner noted a sizeable number of hospital based deaths with diagnoses approved for admission to a hospice inpatient facility, a large service area, lack of inpatient hospice facilities, and the possibility of reducing the cost of care. The petitioner also provided evidence of broad community support and funds pledged for a facility.

With regard to Wake County, the petitioner requested 8 inpatient beds. The eight beds allocated by the committee was consistent with the standard methodology if the existing unit at Rex Hospital had been at 80% occupancy.

With regard to Davidson County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for 6 beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for 4 beds which was consistent with the deficit identified based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of support for inpatient beds in the County.

Regarding Rockingham County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for 3 beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for 3 beds even though the projected deficit was only two beds based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of support for inpatient beds in the County.

#### 2006 Plan

The 2006 Plan contained single county need determinations for 18 counties. The need determinations for Davidson, Durham (the standard methodology indicated a need for 7 versus the 12 beds identified in the Plan), Macon and Wayne counties were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Committee in response to petitions. The need

determinations for the other counties were based on the Standard Methodology. No CON applications were filed for the Macon County need determination.

One of the four counties that received adjusted need determinations exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice and the state average Hospice days of care per 1000 population.

With regard to Macon County, the committee recommended that the petition for 3 additional beds be approved. The closest facilities were in Buncombe and Henderson counties. Macon County had higher % of deaths served by Hospice and average days of care/1000 population than the State average. The petitioner provided evidence of community support and noted creation of a Foundation to provide financial support.

With regard to Durham County, the petitioner requested a total of 12 inpatient beds rather than the 7 bed need determination identified in the Plan. The Committee recommended approval of the petition. The petitioner provided evidence of community support. It was noted that Durham County had a relatively large population and was the site of an academic medical teaching center. Also noted was that the collective projected inpatient beds for the triangle area was 36 while the total number of beds currently licensed or available for CON review was only 27.

With regard to Davidson County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for four beds which was approved by the Committee and was consistent with the deficit identified based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of support for inpatient beds in the County.

Regarding Wayne County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for 6 beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for 6 beds even though there was a projected surplus of one bed based on the standard methodology. Noted was the high level of utilization of the existing facility and the level of support for additional inpatient beds in the County.

# 2007 Plan

The 2007 Plan contains single county need determinations for 9 counties. The need determinations for Alamance, Caldwell, Catawba, Iredell, Rutherford and Scotland counties were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Committee in response to petitions. The need determinations for the other counties were based on the Standard Methodology. The CON application deadline is September 15 for Catawba, Iredell and Rutherford counties.

Five of the six counties that received adjusted need determinations, exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice and four exceeded the state average Hospice days of care per 1000 population.

With regard to Alamance County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for four additional beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need

determination for 2 beds which was consistent with the deficit identified based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services and support for additional beds.

With regard to Caldwell County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for three additional beds which was approved by the Committee and was consistent with the deficit identified based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services and support for additional beds.

With regard to Catawba County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for six, or as an alternative, ten additional hospice inpatient beds. The Committee recommended approval of the petition for six beds. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services and support for additional beds and the projected deficit of six beds.

With regard to Iredell County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for six additional hospice inpatient beds. The Committee recommended approval of the petition for six beds. Noted was the level of support for additional beds. The plan projected a deficit of five beds.

With regard to Rutherford County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for six additional hospice inpatient beds. The Committee recommended approval of the petition for six beds. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services and support for additional beds. The plan projected a deficit of three beds.

Regarding Scotland County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for four beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for four beds which was consistent with the deficit identified based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services and the level of support for additional inpatient beds in the County.

#### **2008 Plan**

The 2008 Plan listed single county need determinations for 14 counties. The need determinations for Cleveland, Forsyth, Haywood, and Macon counties were based on adjusted need determinations recommended by the Committee in response to petitions. The need determinations for Cumberland, Harnett, Lee and Sampson counties were based on reallocation of need determinations identified based on the 2006 Plan using the 2007 Plan methodology. The need determinations for the other counties were based on the Standard Methodology. No CON applications were received for the Haywood, Lee, Lincoln, Macon, Sampson, or Wilson need determinations. The attached revised Table 13C incorporates the changes to the inventory based on no CON applications being filed for these counties. The CON application deadline is November 17 for Cumberland County.

Three of the four counties that received adjusted need determinations, exceeded the state average % deaths served by Hospice and two exceeded the state average Hospice days of care per 1000 population.

With regard to Cleveland County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for four additional beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for four beds which was consistent with the deficit identified based on the standard methodology. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services and support for additional beds.

With regard to Forsyth County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for ten additional beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for ten beds even though there was a projected surplus of two beds in the county. Noted was the level of utilization of hospice services, the population of the county, the existence of two tertiary care centers in the county and the utilization of the existing facility within the Northern Piedmont.

With regard to Haywood County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for six beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination for six beds. There was a three bed deficit identified in the Plan. Noted were geographic access considerations.

With regard to Macon County, the petitioner requested an adjusted need determination for six beds. The committee recommended that there be an adjusted need determination six beds. There was a four bed deficit identified in the Plan. Noted were geographic access considerations and level of utilization of hospice services and support.

# Other

It should be noted that anyone may apply for the beds if it were decided to approve petitions requesting need determinations for inpatient beds. CON applications could be submitted for a hospital based facility, nursing home based facility or a free-standing facility and the facility could be proposed for development anywhere within a county.

The petitions were posted on the Division of Health Service Regulation's web site. No written comments were received by the September 9, 2008 date that was identified for submission of comments on petitions and comments to the Division's Medical Facility Planning Section.

# **ANALYSIS OF INDIVIDUAL PETITIONS**

Petition Inpatient Hospice-1 from Hospice and Palliative Care Center of Alamance-Caswell. The petitioner requests an adjusted need determination for five additional hospice inpatient beds in Alamance County. The petitioner currently has an inpatient facility, Hospice Home, in Alamance County with six inpatient and six residential beds as well as approval for the development of two additional inpatient beds and two additional residential beds.

The Proposed 2009 Plan, page 320, identifies a deficit of five beds in Alamance County, and, as a result, does not identify a need determination for new inpatient hospice beds. However, as noted above, data revisions submitted for several hospice agencies results in changes to need determinations as published in the Proposed 2009 Plan. The revised data would result in a need determination for six beds in Alamance County.

Utilization of Existing Hospice Beds

The Alamance inpatient facility reported 89.59% occupancy for the inpatient beds based on 2008 License Renewal Application information. The previous year the facility reported 94.6% occupancy. Alamance County residents accounted for 93.9% of the days of care at the facility.

Four of the state's existing hospice inpatient facilities are in counties contiguous to Alamance County; two facilities in Guilford County, one in Orange County and one in Rockingham County. Based on 2008 License Renewal Application information, none of the facilities reported any days of care for Alamance County persons. Based on reported utilization, it does not appear that the petition would have a significant impact on utilization of other facilities.

A Certificate of Need has been issued for the development of a new facility with six inpatient beds in Randolph County. It is also noted that the Proposed 2009 Plan contained a six bed need determination for Randolph County; however, revised data would result in elimination of that need determination.

#### Other

As indicated in the Proposed 2009 Plan, Alamance County was higher than the state median % of deaths served by Hospice and the state average days of care/1000 population.

The petitioner provided evidence of community support with letters from the Mayor of Burlington, Alamance Regional Hospital, Kernodle Clinic and the Department of Social Services.

#### Agency Recommendation

The Agency supports the standard methodology. However, the Agency notes the level of utilization of hospice services in Alamance County and the support for additional inpatient beds. If, as a result of revised data, there is not a need determination for six or more beds in Alamance County based on the standard methodology, the Agency recommends that the petition be approved for an adjusted need determination in Alamance County for five inpatient hospice beds. Five beds is consistent with the deficit identified in the Proposed 2008 Plan.

<u>Petition Inpatient Hospice-2</u>: Home Care Services of Haywood Regional Medical Center. The petitioner requests an adjusted need determination for six hospice inpatient beds in Haywood County. There is no hospice inpatient facility in Haywood County.

The Proposed 2009 Plan, page 321, identifies a surplus of two beds in Haywood County and, as a result, does not identify a need determination for new inpatient hospice beds. However, the inventory has been modified to reflect that no CON application was received for the six bed need determination that was identified in the 2008 Plan based on a petition that had been filed. Deletion of the six beds from the inventory results in a deficit of four beds in Haywood County.

Utilization of Existing Hospice Beds

Two of the state's existing hospice inpatient facilities are in counties contiguous to Haywood County; Solace in Buncombe County and Four Seasons in Henderson County. Based on 2008 License Renewal Application information, the Buncombe facility reported 93 days of care for Haywood County (of a total of 5727 days) and the Henderson facility reported no days for Haywood County. Based on reported utilization, it does not appear that the petition would have a significant impact on utilization of existing facilities.

The 2008 Plan contains a need determination for seven additional beds in Henderson County.

## Other

As indicated in the Proposed 2009 Plan, Haywood County was higher than the state median percent of deaths served by Hospice and lower than the state average days of care/1000 population.

As indicated in the background information provided at the beginning of this report, the Committee has recommended allocations of less than six beds and has recommended as few as three beds for counties.

Agency Recommendation: The Agency supports the standard methodology. However, the Agency recommends that the petition be approved to the extent that there be an adjusted need determination for Haywood County in the 2009 Plan. The number of beds identified could be as few as four which is consistent with the deficit identified in the Proposed 2009 Plan or as high as six as requested by the petitioner.

# Petition Inpatient Hospice-3: Hospice of the Carolina Foothills.

The petitioner requests removal of the need determination for six hospice inpatient beds in Polk County.

# Utilization of Existing Hospice Beds

Two of the state's existing hospice inpatient facilities are in counties contiguous to Polk County; Four Seasons in Henderson County and Hospice Home in Rutherford County. Based on 2008 License Renewal Application information, Four Seasons reported no days of care for Polk County and Hospice Home reported that 17 of its total 1386 days were for Polk County residents. The 2008 Plan contains a need determination for seven additional beds in Henderson County. Rutherford County has been approved for the development of six additional beds.

# Other

As indicated in the Proposed 2009 Plan, Polk County was higher than the state median % of deaths served by Hospice and higher than the state average days of care/1000 population.

The petitioner indicates that its service area includes portions of South Carolina. The petitioner states that it is developing a 12 bed hospice inpatient and residential facility in South Carolina approximately four miles from North Carolina. The petitioner indicates the facility is accessed from I-26 and State Highway 14. The petitioner projects a majority of the facility days of care will be for North Carolina residents.

As noted above, Polk County has higher days of care per thousand (1133.31) than the state average (299.59) based on the Proposed 2009 Plan. If the number of inpatient beds projected for Polk County were based on the State average, there would be a projected deficit of only one bed [(299.59 \* 19405/1000 \* .08)/365/.85 = 1.49] rather than the six bed deficit projected in the Proposed 2009 Plan.

Agency Recommendation: The Agency supports the standard methodology. However, the Agency notes the higher days of care/1000 population for Polk County compared to the State average, the development of a hospice facility just four miles from Polk County and the projected utilization of that facility by Polk County residents. Therefore, the Agency recommends that the petition be approved and that there not be a need determination for hospice inpatient beds in the 2009 Plan for Polk County.

Petition Inpatient Hospice-4: Hospice of Scotland County.

The petitioner requests an adjusted need determination for two hospice inpatient beds in Scotland County. The petitioner has a six bed residential facility in Scotland County and has received a CON for development of four inpatient hospice beds. Based on 2008 License Renewal information, the residential facility had an occupancy rate of 84%.

The Proposed 2009 Plan, page 322, identifies a deficit of two beds in Scotland County and, as a result, does not identify a need determination for new inpatient hospice beds in the County.

Utilization of Existing Hospice Beds

One of the existing hospice inpatient facilities is in a county contiguous to Scotland County. Southeastern Regional Medical Center is licensed for 12 inpatient beds and did not report any days of care for Scotland County residents on its 2008 license renewal application. Certificates of Need have been issued for the development of beds in the following three counties which are contiguous to Scotland County; Moore – 11 beds, Richmond – 6 beds, and Robeson – 14 beds.

Other

As indicated in the Proposed 2009 Plan, Scotland County was higher than the state median % of deaths served by Hospice and higher than the state average days of care/1000 population.

The petitioner provided evidence of support with letters of support from Sandhills Regional Medical Center, Scotland Memorial Hospital, Scotland Cancer Treatment Center and citizens.

**Agency Recommendation:** The Agency supports the standard methodology. However, the Agency notes the level of utilization of hospice services in Scotland County and the support for inpatient beds. The Agency recommends that the petition be approved and that there be an adjusted need determination in Scotland County for two additional inpatient hospice beds.

Petition Inpatient Hospice-5: Hospice of Wake County, Inc...

The petitioner requests an adjusted need determination for ten additional hospice inpatient beds in Wake County.

The Proposed 2009 Plan, page 322, identifies a deficit of "0" beds in Wake County and, as a result, does not identify a need determination for new inpatient hospice beds in the County. The "0" bed deficit is based on the fact that the existing six licensed inpatient beds at Rex Hospital in Wake County only reported 76.62% occupancy based on their 2008 License Renewal Application. If the six beds had been utilized at 85%, there would have been a 33 bed deficit and a 33 bed need determination in the Proposed 2009 Plan for Wake County.

# Utilization of Existing Hospice Beds

As noted earlier, the Rex Hospice unit reported only 76.62% occupancy last year. Based on Rex's 2007, 2006, 2005, and 2004 License Renewal Applications, occupancy was only 70.6%, 74.7%, 63.8%, and 55.8% respectively, in the four prior years.

The Rex inpatient unit reported providing 1,466 days of care to Wake County residents. Other than the Rex inpatient unit, the only other licensed inpatient hospice facilities in the State that reported providing inpatient days of care to Wake county residents were the facilities in Orange County which reported only 68 days of care and the facility in Wayne County with 8 days.

A Certificate of Need has been issued to Hospice of Wake County for development of eight inpatient beds in Wake County. These eight beds were identified in the 2005 Plan based on a petition. The petitioner indicates that the six beds currently located at Rex Hospital will be relocated to the new freestanding inpatient hospice facility upon its completion.

One of the existing hospice inpatient facilities is in a county contiguous to Wake County. E. Carlton Powell Hospice House in Harnett County is licensed for seven inpatient beds and did not report any days of care on its 2008 license renewal application for Wake County residents. Certificates of Need have been issued for the development of beds in the following counties which are contiguous to Wake County; Durham -12, Harnett -1, Johnston -8, and Nash -4. In addition, Certificates of Need may be issued for eight additional beds in Harnett County and four additional beds in Nash County based on prior need determinations.

## Other

As indicated in the Proposed 2009 Plan, Wake County was higher than the state median % of deaths served by Hospice and lower than the state average days of care/1000 population. Based on the Proposed 2009 Plan, Wake County had the second highest number of hospice patient deaths (1,468) and the second highest days of care (153,001) of any county in the State.

As indicated in the background information provided at the beginning of this report, the Committee recommended adjusted need determinations for Wake County and Mecklenburg County both of whom had underutilized hospital based inpatient hospice units.

Agency Recommendation: The Agency supports the standard methodology. However, the Agency notes the special circumstances that exist in Wake County with regard to utilization of licensed inpatient hospice beds. The six licensed beds at Rex Hospital have been utilized at less than 85% occupancy for the past several years. Continued utilization at less than 85% will continue to result in no need determination in Wake County based on the standard

methodology. This does not appear to be reasonable in light of the size of Wake County (the second largest population of any county in the state) and the utilization of hospice services.

Therefore, the Agency recommends that the petition be approved and that there be an adjusted need determination in Wake County for ten inpatient hospice beds. With regard to the relocation of the hospice beds from Rex Hospital, the Agency assumes that this will not trigger application of Policy GEN-2: Changes in Need Determinations.
