Re: Comments on the Proposed 2010 State Medical Facilities Plan

Dear Dr. Myers:

We offer the following comments and requests regarding the Proposed 2010 State Medical Facilities Plan on behalf of Charlotte Radiology, P.A.:

- ☐ Mobile MRI. We support the finding that there is no need for any additional mobile MRI scanners anywhere in the state. Further, we recommend the technology committee examine the potential of developing a single need methodology for both mobile and fixed MRI scanners. We believe this recommendation is in line with the following situation and trends:
  - All counties in the state with a hospital (and thus some level of acute care services) currently have direct access to MRI technology;
  - There are many counties in the state with access to multiple fixed and mobile MRI scanners:
  - The current growth rate in total state-wide MRI utilization is negative;
  - Scans per equivalent MRI unit have declined over the last year; and
  - Application of the current fixed MRI need methodology only reflects a need for two additional scanners statewide, further suggesting adequate access to MRI technology across the state.
