I am writing this letter in strong support for CarePartners Hospice & Palliative Care's special need petition to include five inpatient hospice beds for Buncombe County in the 2010 *State Medical Facilities Plan*. The approval of this petition will allow CarePartners Hospice to submit a Certificate of Need application for five additional inpatient hospice beds.

CarePartner Hospice already operates its inpatient beds at full capacity, and there is sometimes a waiting list. In the past year I have referred a number of patients to Hospice, and some of them had to wait for a room at the inpatient Solace Center.
